REACH ACROSS barriers that threaten to stunt our spiritual growth and fellowship by reducing the size of Sabbath School Classes to between 8-10 people in a class – resulting in at least eight adult classes – will mean training more facilitators to lead the lesson study; fellowship together as a church family and in smaller groups to encourage an avenue for disciple making, spiritual growth nurturing and involvement in the life and mission of the church.

REACH OUT to the community through our members (in conjunction with the Small Groups Ministry) by training Bible workers – 3 to 5 Bible Workers added to the pool every year supporting needs based on small groups.
